Statement regarding Kingston CTS

March 26, 2026 – Kingston Community Health Centres (KCHC) acknowledges the recent public discussion regarding the future of our Consumption and Treatment Services (CTS) site.

While we have not yet received formal written notice specific to Kingston, we did receive direct notification from the province in a March 13th meeting that funding for CTS sites, including Kingston's, will end effective June 13. Based on this direction, we immediately began planning for a closure and shared that information with key partners, including the City of Kingston.

The City's response was grounded in the information we received and communicated. In a rapidly evolving and uncertain environment, acting early to prepare for potential service disruption is both reasonable and responsible.

We recognize that the speed and evolving nature of information created confusion, and we deeply regret any lack of clarity in our early communications. At the same time, we remain confident that partners acted appropriately based on the information available at the time.

Across Kingston, there has been a strong and unified response from community partners, staff, and leaders who are working urgently to support clients and explore options to sustain critical services. We are grateful for the City's advocacy and leadership during this time.

KCHC remains in active dialogue with the Ministry and partners to determine next steps and to explore opportunities to maintain supports for the community moving forward. We will continue to provide updates as more information becomes available.
